

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- A. A shooter must be a resident of Indiana and of his or her zone for six months to be eligible for trophies or placement on the zone team.
- B. Members of the ITA Board of Directors, or their designees, shall be in charge of classifications, shoot-offs and awarding of trophies. All trophies will be awarded per ATA trophy rules. They shall also certify the members that will make up the zone 16 Yard Singles and Doubles teams, which will consist of High Score in each class (AA-A-B-C-D), in Events 1 & 2, regardless of category. The first & second team alternates shall be the second and third high-gun in each class.
- C. All shooters must provide for classification their 2018 ATA Average Card, up-to-date with averages computed. Average cards can be printed from the ATA website at <http://www.shootata.com/MyATA.aspx>. If your ATA Average Card is not provided, classification will be at the discretion of the ITA Zone Handicap Committee. Each shooter will also need their plastic ATA card for classification, squadding and cashing.
- D. All registered targets shot in the 2017 and 2018 target years will be counted towards shooter classification.
- 500 targets required for Indiana Zone Singles Championship Event, otherwise will be classified Penalty Class A.
- 500 targets required for Indiana Zone Handicap Championship Event, otherwise will shoot your ATA assigned yardage plus two (2) yards Penalty.
- 300 targets required for Indiana Zone Doubles Championship Event, otherwise will be classified Penalty Class A.
- Target requirements will be waived for Senior Veterans.
- E. Classification will be as follows:

- F. Situations not specifically covered above are subject to applicable A.T.A. rules and decisions of the I.T.A. Zone Handicap Committee made up of the Zone Directors & the Indiana ATA Delegate.
