**Rules and Other Criteria Currently in Place**

(Reviewed and affirmed by action of the ITA Board of Directors ~ Saturday 13 February 2021)

- To be eligible to conduct an Indiana Zone Shoot, the club must have/do the following:
  - Submit a written request to host the zone shoot at which time they will enter into rotation at the bottom of the Zone Rotation list in the year the request was made.
  - Provide a minimum of 4 electric program traps, with walkways to accommodate 27 yard shooters.
  - Enter into a "Zone Shoot Contract" and agree to all conditions of the contract. Sample contract attached.
  - Have approval from the ITA Secretary and ATA authorities for the conduct of the shoot.
- Once a club has been added to the list, they will remain in that rotation until requested to be dropped from the list. If dropped and they request to be re-instated, they will be placed at the bottom of list.
- Zone Shoots must be held on one of the weekends containing the Club's regularly scheduled Sunday(s) in May. An exception to this rule is if the month of May has 5 Sundays, which is normally a free weekend for all clubs. However, if the Zone Shoot is scheduled on a weekend containing the 5th Sunday, no other in-zone club may conduct an ATA shoot on the Zone Shoot weekend or Preliminary date preceding, provided that a Preliminary date is scheduled by the host club.
- A club may alter their weekend to host the Zone Shoot in May if all in-zone clubs normally shooting that weekend agree to the altered date. It will be the requesting club's responsibility to coordinate this change with the other clubs and notify the ITA Secretary. If so agreed, no other in-zone club may conduct an ATA shoot on the Zone Shoot weekend or Preliminary date preceding, provided that a Preliminary date is scheduled by the host club.
- Maximum target fees for Championship Events will be established by the Board of Directors. Clubs may charge a lower target fee but may not exceed the maximum price as stated in the Zone Contract. Preliminary Event fees are at the discretion of the host club. Practice rounds shall not exceed the club's normally advertised market price. Ammunition prices shall not exceed the club's normally advertised market price.
- The host gun club shall forward all ATA and ITA daily fees collected in addition to an ITA trophy fee of \$.02 for each registered target thrown, Championship Events only. Trophy fee is waived for Out-of-Zone shooters (only) if Out-of-Zone trophies are awarded by the host gun club.
- Clubs accepting the Zone Shoot will announce the date of the shoot at the State Shoot Annual Meeting to allow all other gun clubs to schedule their next year's ATA Registered shoots accordingly.
- Winners in the Singles & Doubles Championship Events (including 2nd & 3rd place finishers) will be used to establish the Zone Team(s) and alternates who will compete for the Indiana Zone Team Championship Awards at the state shoot.
- Paperwork (appropriate forms) will be provided to be filled out by the host club and verified by the senior ITA Director in that zone.
